African swine fever (also known as ASF) is a viral disease of pigs and wild boar that is usually deadly. The virus can live in uncooked pork or processed meat for several months and survive in frozen meat for several years. ASF is fatal for pigs, but harmless for humans. Currently, there are neither vaccines 22 cures. For this reason, it 23 major impacts on animal health and economy in affected countries. Smuggling of animals across borders and tourism have made 24 difficult to control the spread of the disease. November 25th is the World Day against Foie Gras. Many people try to express opposition to the torture of force-feeding ducks and geese. Force-feeding causes severe pain and suffering. Over 30 million male ducks undergo this torture every year, in France alone. The fate of females is awful, too: part of them are killed shortly after hatching because they are just not profitable enough.

In order to produce Foie Gras, ducks and geese are force-fed with hydraulic pump, several times per day, until their livers grow up to 10 times their normal size. To stop the animals from escaping, they are limited in small cages where they can never stretch their wings. They have no access to swimming or washing water. During the force-feeding period, the **mortality** rate is up to 20 times more than in traditional bird rearing centers.

Besides the ruthless way of producing Foie Gras, what makes people concerned is that Foie Gras imports are still legal in most parts of the world. As the main Foie Gras producer, France is actively looking for export opportunities to expand its production. But countries like India have proved that a change is possible and many companies worldwide boycott the product. California is about to become the first state in the US to ban Foie Gras. The World Day against Foie Gras is an opportunity to raise awareness about force-feeding.

An incredibly huge amount of trash is dumped into landfills every year around the globe. If you lined it up in garbage trucks, it could circle the Earth 24 times. Sweden has found a way to turn their trash into gold.

About half or 47% of Sweden's waste is recycled. The program recycles and sorts metals, plastics, newspapers, batteries, and electronics. The remaining 52% of the country's waste like excluded scrap, circuit boards, and agricultural waste is used for the country's waste-to-energy program, or WTE program, which produces electricity from burning waste. So what is left is one remarkable percent of Sweden's trash that actually ends up in a landfill.

But how exactly does garbage turn into energy? After recyclable content has been removed, the trash is brought to the waste-to-energy plant. There, the trash gets loaded into furnaces and burned, which generates a large amount of steam that spins generator turbines, producing electricity for the nation's power grid. On recycling, all leftover metals are separated and recycled while the other remaining materials that cannot be burned, like porcelain or tile, are collected for gravel in road construction. Over the past decade, Sweden has run out of their own garbage and had to start importing trash from other countries like UK. It's a win-win situation for most countries since shipping trash to Sweden is not only cheaper than landfill taxes, but it also makes sure more garbage is reused. Over time, Sweden has become a zero waste nation and encouraged other countries to consider it.
