Gordon Sumner (also known as Sting), a musician, was born and raised in the shadow of a shipyard in a little town on the northeast coast of England. His earliest memories were of giant ships at the end of the street, blocking out the sun. Every morning, what he did was look at thousands of people doing the backbreaking labor of building giant vessels that would transport cargo, soldiers, or guests across the world’s seas. Although the shipyard was noisy, dangerous and highly toxic, the men and women who worked on those ships were extraordinarily proud of the work they did. Thus, Gordon’s father wanted his own son to become one of them.

Gordon Sumner was accustomed to the life of the shipyard; however, he had his own dreams, the ones that took him far from the grimy port of his youth. After leaving his hometown, Gordon registered for the University of Warwick in Coventry, but quit school very quickly. Later, Gordon worked as a bus conductor, tax officer and even a teacher in the daytime, whereas he performed jazz during evenings and weekends. Gordon had successfully written his life’s story in his songs, and these songs struck a chord with millions of fans. From Gordon’s memoir, in addition to the elements of rock, jazz, reggae, classical, new-age and worldbeat in music, Gordon’s backstory wrapped in the events had helped him receive 17 Grammy Awards and other big prizes.
