Dicky's response completely **threw** Kenji **off**! He really had no clue about what he'd done wrong!

Antonio is from Spain. Last year, he flew to Tokyo to visit his friends. One night, he walked into a local ramen restaurant for dinner. It turned out that he really loved the ramen he'd ordered. To thank the chef, he did what most Europeans would do: he gave him a big tip. However, the chef looked unhappy on seeing Antonio's tip. He shook his head and threw the tip back to Antonio, leaving him wondering what had just happened!

But do you know that a dog may also have its "teenage rebellion" period?

Plenty of dog owners know that a dog is most adorable when it's still a puppy. Not only does it look very cute but it also follows every order it's given. At this stage, its master almost has no problem training it to do anything, including sitting down, or fetching a ball. However, when it becomes 8 months or one year old, things are completely different! Like a human teenager, it starts to ignore its master's orders, or at least follow them very hesitantly. When its master wants to punish it, it may run away angrily. (In experiencing their dogs' "teenage rebellion," some owners may get frustrated and decide to get rid of them!)

Nowadays, more and more people believe that animals, like humans, have their own rights. That is, a young dog doesn't deserve to be abandoned only because it has become a bit more rebellious.
