Many people must have heard the story about Oskar Schindler, a German businessman who saved the lives of 1,200 Jews during the Holocaust in WWII. He is the subject of the 1993 film *Schindler's List* and came to show extraordinary courage and dedication in saving the lives of his Jewish employees. Less well-known is the story of Sir Nicholas Winton, helping to rescue 669 Jewish children from Nazi-occupied Czechoslovakia before the war broke out in 1939.

Nicholas Winton was born in London in 1909. He bribed the government officials to get all the requirements and documents of bringing the Jewish children from Czechoslovakia to Britain and finding homes and sponsors for them. At that time, the British government made very strict laws for the entry of refugees. For instance, refugees must be younger than 17 years old and they had to pay £50 (that was a lot of money at the time) for their eventual return to go back home.

The most touching part of the story is that Sir Winton stayed quiet for half a century about what he had done for those children. He didn't feel the need to bring attention to his act. His kind deeds went unnoticed by the world until 1988, when he was invited to the BBC television program "*That's Life!*," where he was reunited with dozens of the children he had helped come to Britain. "*That's life!*" was one of the most popular television programs of the 1980s. Few episodes were as powerful as the one broadcast of Nicholas Winton on 27 February 1988. Near the end of the show, the host showed a notebook that listed the names of hundreds of Jewish children brought to Britain from Prague in 1939. One of the names was Vera Diamant, a ten-year-old girl, whose parents had arranged for her to start a new life in Britain. Both Vera and Winton were in the audience. As the camera picked her out, viewers saw an old man sitting next to her. Neither the old man nor Vera knew they had been 'set up' by the TV show. All of a sudden, the host announced that the old man was called Nicholas Winton, and that 50 years earlier he had saved the lives of Vera and hundreds of other children. The two embraced as Winton wiped tears from his eyes.

The British press honored Winton and **dubbed** him the "British Schindler." In 2003, Winton was knighted by Queen Elizabeth II for "service to humanity, in saving Jewish children from Nazi Germany."
