

Agatha Christie, born in England in 1890, is one of the most famous and productive writers in the history of literature. Known as the “Queen of Mystery,” she wrote 66 detective novels, 14 short stories, and the world’s longest-running play, *The Mousetrap*. Her works have sold over two billion copies worldwide, making her one of the best-selling authors of all time. According to UNESCO’s Index, she remains the most-translated individual author, only outnumbered by the Bible and Shakespeare. Her novel *And Then There Were None* is one of the top-selling books, with approximately 100 million copies sold.

Agatha was born into an upper-middle-class family. She was the youngest of three children. Christie was homeschooled by her mother, who encouraged her to write from a young age. Despite having no formal education until her teens, Agatha developed a love for reading and storytelling. During World War I, Agatha worked as a nurse, and she acquired knowledge about poisons, which would feature in her later works. Agatha Christie’s writing is characterized by her complex plots and surprising endings. Some of her most famous works include *Murder on the Orient Express*, *Death on the Nile*, *And Then There Were None*, and *The A.B.C. Murders*.

In 1926, Christie experienced a personal crisis when her mother died, and her husband was found having an affair. Shortly after, Agatha disappeared for 11 days, leading to a nationwide search. She was eventually found staying at a hotel under a fake name, suffering from memory loss. The reasons behind her disappearance remain a mystery, but it was a turning point in her life. In 1930, Agatha married archaeologist Sir Max Mallowan, whom she met during an archaeological dig in the Middle East. The marriage was a happy one, and she often accompanied her husband on adventures, which inspired settings for several of her novels.

Agatha Christie's contribution to literature was recognized with numerous awards. In 1955, Christie was the first recipient of the Mystery Writers of America's Grand Master Award. Later that year, *Witness for the Prosecution* received an Edgar Award for the best play. In 2013, she was voted the best crime writer and *The Murder of Roger Ackroyd* the best crime novel ever by 600 professional novelists of the Crime Writers' Association. Her works have been adapted for numerous films, television series, and stage plays, continuing to captivate audiences around the world.
