We are in the COVID-19 pandemic, and we have no idea when this is going to end. To understand the situation, the KFF (Kaiser Family Foundation) did a survey on March 11-15, 2020 and surprisingly found that there were some differences in how men and women respond to the pandemic. First of all, more women than men said that their lives had been bothered by the pandemic (49% vs. 40%). Next, women, compared with men, were more likely to stay home instead of going to work or other regular activities (81% vs. 69%). Women would rather choose to change or cancel their travel plans than men (72% vs. 66%) or to shelter in the current location (88% vs. 76%). In fact, when the outbreak became more severe (two weeks after the first poll taken), KFF did a second survey—one sex gap has gotten strikingly larger, particularly among parents. Women overall were 16 percentage points more likely than men to say that worry or stress related to coronavirus had a negative impact on their mental health. Among parents of children under age 18, the sex gap reached a striking 25%. In the poll taken just two weeks prior, namely, in the first survey, the sex gap among all adults was 9 percentage points (36% vs. 27%) and among parents, it was just 5 percentage points (36% vs. 31%). To conclude, women are more likely to worry about both the health and economic effects of a pandemic on their families, and the worry would become even more if they have children under 18.
