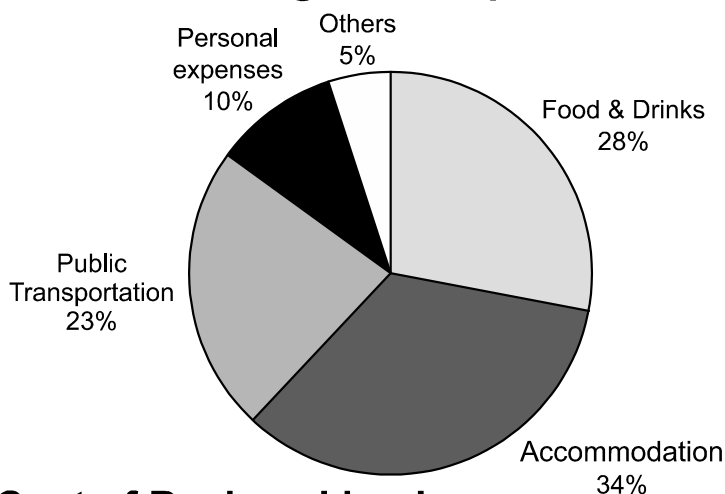

In the history of civilization, humans have spared no effort to fight for their rights but have hardly given “human rights” a clear definition. In general, human rights are entitled to every person without any conditions. That is, no matter where you come from, what you believe in, or how you live a life, you deserve to be treated as equally as any other person in this world.

The notion of human rights appeared in 539 B.C. when the first king of Persia, Cyrus the Great, released slaves. As for its popularization, we could trace its history back to the time when people strived for legal civil rights. The Great Charter (1215) was made to remind people that even a king cannot change laws at will. Hundreds of years later, the Petition of Rights in 1628 officially stopped kings’ abuse of power. From then on, more people were allowed to fight for their civil liberties.

However, to fulfill the fundamental human rights, **the above** was not enough. In the 1700s, the core of human rights turned into an emphasis on one’s freedom. The basic civil rights to organize government were announced and publicized officially in the Constitution of the U.S.A. To perfect the notion of human rights, the Bill of Rights (1791) further guaranteed liberties to an individual, such as freedom of speech, religion, assembly, and petition*.

Today, people not just seek for the equality of civil rights, but focus more on the rights for individual needs. For example, Human Rights Act (1998) laid down the law to prevent personality rights from being violated. Personal data, like financial condition, contact information, or even personal photos, should not be given away without permission. Besides, we still make efforts to reveal hidden unfairness happening between genders or in family relations. Perhaps, the definitions of human rights might continue changing with time.
